

Greater Carlyle USBC

September 23, 2018 Meeting

The Greater Carlyle USBC Bowling Association (GCBA) meeting was called to order at 1:05 PM at Hanks Bowl in Trenton by President Darrell Rinderer.

Roll call of GCBA Board Members was taken with ten (13) directors present. GCBA officers present were: President Darrell Rinderer, Vice-President Danny Schrempp, Second Vice-President, and Pam Yates. GCBA house representatives present were: Jeff Voss (Grantfork Bowl), Sam Turley (4th Street Lanes), Gregg Suydam (Hanks Bowl), Chris Marshall (Hi Top Bowl), Mike Klein (Mascoutah Lanes), Greg Walter (Poplar Junction Lanes), Alan Profancik (Salem Bowl), Glen Summann (Vandalia Bowl), Sarah Berger (Youth Director), and Cindy Ogden (Youth Director).

Association Manager Tim Rutz was also present.

Cindy Ogden made a motion to accept the minutes from the June 10, 2018 special meeting. Chris Marshall seconded the motion. The motion carried by a vote of thirteen (13) for and zero (0) against.

Tim Rutz stated that he does not have an actual income statement because he has not received funds from any of the merged association except for the Vandalia WBA. Sarah Berger stated that she needed a statement from the GCBA saying that the funds from the Southwest Illinois Youth Association would be going to the GCBA before she could close out the account and transfer the funds to the GCBA. He then stated that all of the deposits and withdrawals from sanctions this early in the season don't give a true income value. Nevertheless, Tim stated that so far this season he is showing a net income of \$830.44.

Greg Walter made a motion to accept the finance report. Jeff Voss seconded the motion. The motion carried by a vote of thirteen (13) for and zero (0) against.

Tim Rutz stated that after a lengthy and frustrating process, the merger is finally complete. The name of the association will be Greater Carlyle USBC and the new association number is 86694. He then stated that for him to legally talk to the IRS and the State of Illinois he needs to be voted in as an officer of the GCBA.

Mike Klein made a motion to make Tim Rutz an officer of the GCBA. Cindy Ogden seconded the motion. The motion carried by a vote of thirteen (13) for and zero (0) against.

Tim Rutz stated that all of the certifications have been completed. He stated that he will start conducting lane inspections soon, and hopes to have them all completed by November 1st. Sam Turley asked Tim if he was able to get the computerize lane reader working. Tim stated that he hasn't had time to mess with it and that he was considering going on a Face Book page set up for associations to buy and sell old equipment to see if there was anything available. Tim stated that he couldn't see spending \$2500 on a new reader.

Tim Rutz stated that the GCBA Hall of Fame and Awards Banquet will be held on Saturday, November 3rd. Wayne Anderson from Highland, Scott Feist from New Baden, and Larry Wobbe from Breese were approved by the GCBA Hall of Fame Committee as this year's new inductees. Tim Rutz asked the house representatives to deliver the hall of fame and awards banquet invitations to the honor score bowlers. The reply deadline is October 24th.

Tim Rutz stated that the GCBA Senior Scratch will be held on Sunday, November 4th at 11:00 AM at Mascoutah Lanes. The event will be limited to the first 40 entries. The cost of the event is \$50.00 and must accompany the entry blank. Tim stated that the format is the same as last year to reward the top qualifiers. He asked the house representatives to take the entry blanks to their bowling centers. Mike Klein asked if we had a list of bowlers that bowled last year. Tim stated that he usually provides the directors a list of previous bowlers, but he forgot it for this meeting.

Tim Rutz stated that the GCBA Scratch Classic will be held on Sunday, December 9th at 11:00 AM at Vandalia Bowl. The event will be limited to the first 60 entries. The cost of the event is \$40.00 and must accompany the entry blank. Tim stated that the format is the same as last year with each bowler bowling five games – rotating one pair of lanes to the right after each game. He then asked the house representatives to take entry blanks to their bowling centers.

Tim Rutz stated that the 77th Annual GCBA Team Tournament will be held at V&H Recreation in Breese. It is scheduled to begin on Saturday, March 2, 2019 and run through Sunday, March 31, 2019. Squad times will be at 2:00 PM and 7:00 PM on Saturdays. There will be one squad at Noon on Sundays. The GCBA Singles & Doubles Tournament will be held at Vandalia

Bowl. It will begin on Saturday, March 2, 2019 and run through Sunday, March 31, 2019. Squad times will be at 2:00 PM and 7:00 PM on Saturdays. There will be one squad at Noon on Sundays. He stated that handicap will remain at 80% of 220 and the entry fee will increase to \$25 per event per person for team, singles, and doubles. This tournament will be an Open Tournament open to all members of the GCBA.

Tim Rutz stated that the Women's Tournament Committee is currently working on the rules for the Women's Tournament. He stated that the Women's Tournament will be bowled at the same tournament sites as the Open Tournament using the same shifts on opposite ends of the bowling centers. The Women's Tournament is open only to female members of the GCBA.

Sam Turley asked what we will do if there isn't enough room for the number of entries we get for both tournaments. Tim Rutz stated that based on last year's tournaments he believes there should be plenty of room to accommodate both tournaments. He then stated that he talked to both tournament sites and was assured that we could add additional shifts if necessary.

Tim Rutz stated that the GCBA will continue to give out the generic awards (200 game, 275 game, 500 series, 700 series, etc). He stated that the GCBA will also give out an 11 in a row plaque as well as an award for 100 pins over average in one game for all bowlers. There will also be an award for female bowlers who bowl a game over 275 (one per person per season for all awards). Tim stated that plaques for a 299 game, 300 game, and 800 series will be awarded at the following year's banquet.

Tim Rutz stated that the GCBA Scholarship Application will be available at the November meeting. The deadline to submit the application is April 1, 2019. He stated that we need to get the word out that this scholarship is available.

Tim Rutz stated that he has received about five or six league sanctions so far. He stated that the sanctions are due 30 days from the first night of the season.

Tim Rutz stated that if there are no objections he would like to switch the meeting locations for the November and January meetings. He stated that Hi Top Bowl has a 700 Club meeting when they are scheduled to host the January 27^{th} meeting. Tim stated that he talked to Hi Top and V&H Recreation and they are both able to accommodate the switch. The November 25^{th} meeting will be at Hi Top Bowl in Highland and the January 27^{th} meeting will be at V&H Recreation in Breese. Tim Rutz asked the house representatives to take the scratch entry forms, average books and annual reports to their bowling centers.

The next meeting is scheduled for Sunday, November 25, 2018 at 1:00 PM at Hi Top Bowl in Highland.

Gregg Suydam made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 1:49 PM. Cindy Ogden seconded the motion. The motion carried by a vote of thirteen (13) for and zero (0) against.

Greater Carlyle USBC Bowling Association

November 25, 2018 Meeting

The Greater Carlyle USBC Bowling Association (GCBA) meeting was called to order at 1:03 PM by President Darrell Rinderer at Hi Top Bowl in Highland.

Roll call of GCBA Board Members was taken with fifteen (15) officers and house representatives present. GCBA officers present were: President Darrell Rinderer, First Vice President Danny Schrempp, Second Vice President Pam Yates, and Association Manager Tim Rutz.

GCBA house representatives present were: Scott Feist (Baden Bowl), Mike Gebke (Bartelso Bowl), Jeff Voss (Grantfork Bowl), Sam Turley (4th Street Lanes), Shelly Hennessy (Hanks Bowl), Chris Marshall (Hi Top Bowl), Greg Walter (Poplar Junction Lanes), Ron Maue (V&H Recreation), Glen Summann (Vandalia Bowl), Cindy Ogden (Youth Director), and Pam Schrumpf (Highland Rep).

Tim Rutz stated that Alan Profancik was not listed as being present in the September 23rd minutes. He stated that he added Alan's name to the corrected minutes.

Scott Feists made a motion to accept the minutes from the September 23, 2018 meeting. Ron Maue seconded the motion. The motion carried by a vote of fifteen (15) for and zero (0) against.

Tim Rutz asked the board if he needs to show separate balances for the Open, Women's, and Youth Tournaments or if he could lump them all into one balance. It was mentioned that each tournament should be self-sufficient, so each should have its own balance.

Jeff Voss made a motion to accept the financial statements. Pam Yates seconded the motion. The motion carried by a vote of fifteen (15) for and zero (0) against.

Tim Rutz stated that the GCBA Senior Scratch Classic was held November 4th at Mascoutah Lanes. Twenty-three (23) bowlers competed in the event – nine in the under 60 age division, and fourteen in the 60 and older age division. Tim stated that was one more than we had last year. He stated that it is mainly the same bowlers each year, and that they enjoy the tournament. He then suggested that if we go below 20 bowlers, we should discontinue the tournament. Scott Feist asked if we are losing money on the tournament. Tim stated that we break even. Chris Marshall asked if anyone asked why we didn't drop the entry fee for the senior scratch tournament like we did for the regular scratch tournament. Tim replied that he did get that question from one bowler. He explained that we dropped the regular scratch entry to try to get more bowlers. He then stated that if we would drop the senior entry fee we wouldn't have much of a prize fund. Steve Bann was the overall champion. Next year's tournament is scheduled for Bartelso Bowl. Tim thanked Danny Schrempp, Mike Klein, and Dave Wirz for all of their help during the tournament.

Tim Rutz stated that the GCBA Scratch Classic is scheduled for Sunday, December 9th at Vandalia Bowl. He stated that he only has about ten bowlers signed up for the event. He gave the directors a list of bowlers that bowled last year to see if they were interested in bowling this year.

Tim Rutz stated that the entry forms are available for the 2019 GCBA Handicap Tournament. The team event begins March 2, 2019 at V&H Recreation in Breese. Singles & doubles is at Vandalia bowl and also begins on March 2, 2019. Tim stated that the entry deadline is January 27th. He then asked the house representatives to take the entry forms and posters to their bowling centers.

Tim Rutz stated that the GCBA Youth Tournament Committee is working on the specifics for the GCBA Youth Tournament. He stated that entry forms will be available at the January meeting.

Tim Rutz stated that he has GCBA Scholarship applications for the directors to take to their bowling center. Applications are due April 1, 2019.

The GCBA Hall of Fame and Awards Banquet was held November 3rd. Tim stated 120 people attended the banquet. Three members were inducted into the GCBA Hall of Fame, so we now seventy members. Pam Schrumpf asked if the banquet is always held at Michaels. She questioned the quality of the food. She suggested looking into moving the banquet to Diamond

Mineral Springs in Grantfork. Tim stated the banquet was moved to Michaels when we included the awards with the hall of fame banquet. Tim stated that Dave Wirz is in charge of the hall of fame, and that Dave takes care of the banquet. He stated that he would talk to Dave about the concerns. Tim stated that the deadline to submit an application for next year is July 1, 2019. Applications are available on the GCBA Website.

Tim Rutz stated that the Illinois USBC Annual Meeting is Saturday, March 16, 2019 at 11:00 AM in Bloomington. He stated that we are allowed 15 delegates, and that he would submit 15 names in case anyone decides they want to go. Jeff Voss asked Tim if he was planning to go. Jeff said he would go with him. Tim stated that he didn't plan to go since it was in the middle of the GCBA Tournament, but if it works out he may go.

Jeff then asked if Tim heard anything about awards on the state level. Tim stated that he inquired about awards when he got the hall of fame certificates about a month ago. He was told that the state board was going to meet to discuss their awards program soon. Tim stated that he would contact state to see what they came up with.

Tim Rutz asked the directors to take a look at the printout of honor scores submitted so far this season. He asked the directors to let him know if there are any scores that they know about in their bowling center that are not listed on the printout. He then reminded the directors to remind the secretaries to submit all 299 games, 300 games, and 800 series. Scott Feist stated that two scores from Baden Bowl were not on the printout. Tim stated that he was aware of those awards, and would include them.

Tim Rutz discussed the USBC's Registered Volunteer and SafeSport Program. With USBCs association with the United States Olympic Committee (USOC), he stated that they are requiring all local association board members to complete the SafeSport Program and Register as a Volunteer which includes a background check and cost \$21.25 per person. He stated that the SafeSport Program needed to be completed online. Once that is completed, USBC will contact you and you can complete the Registered Volunteer. Tim stated that GCBA would reimburse the directors for the cost of the Registered Volunteer. Chris Marshall stated that he believes that USBC is requiring these programs to show the USOC that the USBC is on board with their policies hoping to improve their chances to make bowling an Olympic Sport. He then stated that if USBC would have stated that when they announced these requirements, the programs would have been more receptive by the local associations.

Cindy Ogden asked if the GCBA did any fundraising in the past. Tim Rutz stated that they did not other than the 50/50 drawings conducted during the association tournaments. Cindy then suggested doing a basket of booze raffle. Tim stated that the Highland Bowling Team did a bowling ball raffle during the GBCA singles and doubles tournament last year and raised a thousand dollars. Chris Marshall stated that if we did a ball raffle, he could probably get Storm and/or Roto Grip to donate a ball or two.

The next meeting will be held at V&H Recreation in Breese on Sunday, January 27, 2018 at 1:00 PM. Lunch will be provided around 2:30 PM.

Danny Schrempp made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Pam Schrumpf seconded the motion. The motion carried by a vote of fifteen (15) for and zero against. The meeting adjourned at 2:10 PM.

Hi Top Bowl provided sloppy joes and chips after the meeting. GCBA would like to thank Ray Voss and Hi Top Bowl for their hospitality.

Greater Carlyle USBC January 27, 2019 Meeting

The Greater Carlyle USBC Bowling Association (GCBA) meeting was called to order at 1:05 PM at V&H Recreation in Breese by First Vice President Danny Schrempp.

Roll call of GCBA Board Members was taken with seventeen (17) officers and house representatives present. GCBA officers present were: First Vice President Danny Schrempp, Second Vice President Pam Yates and Association Manager Tim Rutz. GCBA house representatives present were: Scott Feist (Baden Bowl), Mike Gebke (Bartelso Bowl), Jeff Voss (Grantfork Bowl), Sam Turley (4th Street Lanes), Gregg Suydam (Hanks Bowl), Shelly Hennessy (Hanks Bowl), Mike Klein (Mascoutah Lanes), Greg Walter (Poplar Junction Lanes), Alan Profancik (Salem Bowl), Ron Maue (V&H Recreation), Glen Summann (Vandalia Bowl), Cindy Ogden (Youth Director), Sarah Berger (Youth Director), and Pam Schrumpf (Highland Rep).

Scott Feist made a motion to accept the minutes from the November 25, 2018 meeting. Ron Maue seconded the motion. The motion carried by a vote of seventeen (17) for and zero (0) against.

Pam Schrumpf made a motion to accept the financial reports. Greg Walter seconded the motion. The motion carried by a vote of seventeen (17) for and zero (0) against.

Tim Rutz stated that the GCBA Scratch Classic was held on December 9th at Vandalia Bowl. He stated that forty-three (43) bowlers (including five female bowlers) participated in the tournament. He stated that he was pleasantly surprised with the number of entries. Tim then suggested that we run a separate female scratch tournament in conjunction to the regular scratch tournament. It would be the same date/time/location with a separate prize fund. Jeff Voss asked if they would also have a separate step ladder final and if they would be able to cash in both tournaments. Tim stated that he the finals would have to depend on the number of entries and would have to be spelled out in the rules. He then stated that the female bowlers would have to specify which tournament they would be participating in, and could only cash in that tournament unless they pay an entry fee for both tournaments. Tim stated that we keep the entry fee at \$40 and run the tournament the Sunday after deer season. Next year's GCBA Singles Scratch Tournament is tentatively scheduled for Sunday, December 15, 2019 at Salem Bowl. Tim then thanked Darrell Rinderer, Pam Yates, and Scott Feist for all of their help during the Scratch Tournament.

Tim Rutz stated that the deadline to submit applications for the GCBA Scholarship is April 1, 2019. Tim asked the directors to remind their center's youth leagues and coaches about the GCBA Scholarship. Applications should be in all GCBA Bowling Centers and is available on the GCBA website.

The deadline to turn in hall of fame applications is July 1, 2019. Applications are available on the GCBA website.

Tim Rutz stated that USBC sent out an email reminder about the SafeSport Program and the Registered Volunteer Program. They required all local and state association directors to complete both programs by January 1, 2019. However, USBC did not say what would happen if a director did not complete both programs. Sarah Berger stated that she believes nothing will happen. She believes that as long as most of the board members complete the programs, USBC will leave us alone.

Tim Rutz stated that so far the number of team entries for the OPEN handicap tournament is comparable to last year, but the number of singles and doubles entries is significantly lower. He stated that we currently have reservations for 93 teams and 250 singles – compared to 88 teams and 320 singles the same time last year. He stated that we also have 25 WOMEN's teams and 80 WOMEN's singles signed up so far. The team event is at V&H Recreation in Breese. Singles and doubles is at Vandalia Bowl. He then asked each tournament site for their committee members.

Tim asked the board of directors if they thought it would be an issue if he mixed a few of the OPEN tournament singles and doubles bowlers with the WOMEN bowlers only if there was a space availability issue. For instance, if there was only two singles OPEN bowlers scheduled to bowl in a shift, he would like to have them bowl with the WOMEN bowlers. He then stated that he would not allow only two bowlers on a pair of lanes for singles and double. He also stated that he would not allow an OPEN team to bowl on the same pair of lanes as a WOMEN's team unless either of the teams requested and both teams agreed. The board agreed that it should be permissible for OPEN tournament singles bowlers and WOMEN's tournament singles bowlers to bowl on the same lanes, but it might be a good idea to ask both for permission. Tim stated that he would get permission from both if that situation comes up.

Tim Rutz stated that the preliminary schedule should be available by February 3rd. He stated that he would email the preliminary schedule to every bowling center and/or house representative that have the ability to receive email. The preliminary schedule would also be available on the GCBA Web Site.

Tim Rutz stated that at our November meeting the board discussed running a bowling ball raffle at the tournament sites. He stated that Chris Marshall stated that he would be able to get at least one ball from Roto Grip representative, Chris Schlemer. The board agreed that we should proceed with the raffle.

The Greater Carlyle USBC Youth Tournament is scheduled for Saturday, April 13 and Sunday, April 14 at Hi Top Bowl in Highland starting at 10:00 AM both days. Tim Rutz stated that he has an entry form for each GCBA sanctioned youth bowler with their name and ID number already filled in - for the house representatives to take back to their bowling center. He stated that Salem Bowl self processed their youth league, so he didn't have a list of their bowlers but did have a stack of entries for them. Tim stated that we have 171 youth bowlers in the GCBA. He then stated that we opened up the tournament to all sanctioned youth bowlers (not just GCBA Youth Bowlers), in an effort to gain more entries.

Tim Rutz stated that he finally received the awards form for the State Awards. He stated that they are offering eight different awards including a once a lifetime pullover for an 800 series. He then handed out award forms for the directors to give to their league secretaries. Tim stated that the State is asking for a lot of information on the award form including the league secretary's signature and the association manager's signature which means the league secretary will have to send their form to him to sign and submit. Jeff Voss stated that it sounds like the State made the form so complicated that no one will want to submit awards.

Tim Rutz advised the directors that most bowlers should have received their sanction card. He stated that each individual's profile on bowl.com will show when a card was mailed. He stated that replacement cards could be printed at bowl.com, but USBC will not mail replacement cards.

Tim Rutz asked the house representatives to look at the printout of the honor scores bowled so far this season and compare it to the scores bowled in their center to make sure all of the honor scores have been turned in. Sam Turley stated that Rob Turley's 300 game was not listed on the printout. Jeff Voss stated that Larry Sussenbach's 300 game was not listed on the printout. Tim stated that he was aware of both awards, and he would get them in the computer.

Tim Rutz read a list of USBC proposed amendments for the annual convention. The board briefly discussed the proposals, but didn't want to get too involved since they still needed to be voted on. The convention is April 29-May 2.

Tim Rutz stated that the meetings for the 2019-20 season will be discussed at the annual meeting in April. Tim Rutz asked the house representatives to talk to their bowling centers to see if they were interested in hosting a meeting next season. Tentative meeting dates are: September 15 or 22, November 17, January 26, and April 19 or 26.

The next meeting is scheduled for April 28th at 1:00 PM at Baden Bowl. This is our annual meeting. Everyone is invited to attend, and the tournament checks will be available at this meeting.

Ron Maue made a motion to adjourn. Greg Walter seconded the motion. The motion carried by a vote of seventeen (17) for and zero (0) against. The meeting adjourned at 2:04 PM.

Greater Carlyle USBC

April 29, 2018 Meeting

The Greater Carlyle USBC (GCBA) Annual Meeting was called to order at 1:04 PM at Baden Bowl in New Baden by President Darrell Rinderer.

A moment of silence was observed for former GCBA Hall of Famer and Director, Royce Fletcher.

Roll call of GCBA Board Members was taken with seventeen (17) officers and house representatives present. GCBA officers present were: President Darrell Rinderer, First Vice President Danny Schrempp, Second Vice President Pam Yates, and Association Manager Tim Rutz. GCBA house representatives present were: Scott Feist (Baden Bowl), Mike Gebke (Bartelso Bowl), Jeff Voss (Grantfork Bowl), Sam Turley (4th Street Lanes), Gregg Suydam (Hanks Bowl), Chris Marshall (Hi Top Bowl), Mike Klein (Mascoutah Lanes), Greg Walter (Poplar Junction Lanes), Alan Profancik (Salem Bowl), Ron Maue (V&H Recreation), Glen Summann (Vandalia Bowl), Sarah Berger (Youth Director), and Cindy Ogden (Youth Director).

A total of seventeen (17) delegates were present which was enough for a quorum.

Ron Maue made a motion to accept the minutes from the January 27, 2019 meeting. Scott Feist seconded the motion. The motion passed by a vote of sixteen (16) for and zero (0) against.

Glen Summann made a motion to accept the financial statements. Sam Turley seconded the motion. The motion passed by a vote of sixteen (16) for and zero (0) against.

Ron Maue stated that everything went well during the GCBA Team Tournament at V&H Recreation. He stated that the scores were good, brackets were good, and the 50/50 drawings were good. He stated that a portion of the bracket proceeds were used for the Greater Carlyle Youth Tournament as well as the V&H Youth League.

Glen Summann stated that the GCBA Singles & Doubles Tournament at Vandalia Bowl went fairly well. He stated that there were a few complaints, but the scores were decent. Glen suggested starting an hour earlier on Saturday, so it isn't so late when they finish.

Tim Rutz recommended changing the Women's Tournament average base to 220 which is the same as the Open Tournament. He stated that making the women's average base the same as the Open Tournament average base would make it easier for the house secretary to figure handicap for substitutes during singles and doubles. With different average bases, the house secretary had to use a different handicap charts for the Women's Tournament and the Open Tournament. This would allow them to use one handicap chart. However, he stated that it wouldn't make a difference for the team event since the Open Tournament uses a five person team and the Women's Tournament uses a four person team.

Tim Rutz stated that teams as well as singles and doubles bowlers from the Open Tournament and the Women's Tournament will have to bowl on the same pair of lanes. He stated that this will especially be necessary in six lane bowling centers. He stated that otherwise they might have some shifts with an open lane.

Jeff Voss stated that he would like to see bowlers that bowl all three events more than once a chance to cash in all events more than once. He stated that they would have to use their second time bowled in each event. Jeff then stated that we have bowlers that support our tournament by bowling multiple times in each event, so they should have a chance to cash multiple times in each event, including all events. Tim Rutz stated that if we allowed cashing multiple times in all events, it would have to be like singles where a bowler can cash once in handicap and once in scratch. Tim stated that this would have to be tracked by hand since the computer cannot be programmed to pick up a second set of all events. He then stated that he would be afraid that he might miss a bowlers second all events score. Tim suggested that the tournament committee discuss this further.

Tim Rutz stated that we did have inclement weather during the first Sunday of the tournament. He stated that our inclement weather policy is explained in the schedule book. All of the singles and doubles bowlers showed up to bowl, but one team decided not to travel from Vandalia to V&H. That team was rescheduled.

Tim Rutz stated that we raised \$507 from the ball raffles conducted during the tournament. He stated that Chris Marshall with Lane Zero Pro Shop donated two bowling balls for the raffles. However, Tim stated that he didn't realize Chris would be donating the balls. Tim stated that he did not want Chris to donate both balls, so he paid Chris for one of the balls, much to the dismay of Chris. Tim added that he took this upon himself to pay Chris for one ball without board approval. He then stated that he hopes the board is okay with his decision.

Tim Rutz stated that next year's team event will be held at Grantfork Bowl. Jeff Voss stated that Grantfork Bowl has two other house tournaments next Winter/Spring so scheduling may be difficult. Tim stated that we will figure it out. The singles and doubles events will be held at 4th Street Lanes in Greenville. Tim stated that singles and doubles was scheduled for Salem Bowl, but Salem bowled declined to host the tournament since March is their biggest month for open bowl.

Tim Rutz stated that we had 56 bowlers competing in the first Greater Carlyle Youth Tournament covering three male divisions and three female divisions. He stated that there was an issue with the lane machine that wasn't discovered until after the first shift which made the lanes play very slick. Tim stated that the shot from the first shift could not be duplicated without taking a chance of damaging the lane machine. He stated that he had a request from a bowler from the first shift to reschedule since there was a lane machine issue. However, Tim stated that in accordance to USBC once scores are shot they stand even if an issue with the lane machine is founded. On a brighter side, Hi Top Bowl gave away two bowling balls, one each day even before they knew there was an issue with the lane machine.

Tim stated that he used \$117 from the GCBA Scholarship Fund, which was not disputed in an earlier email to the board and \$115 from proceeds from the handicap tournament brackets, and \$130 from a ball raffle conducted during the Youth Tournament towards the Youth Tournament Prize Fund. He then stated that he would like to use 20% of the funds from the scholarship 50/50 raffle collected during the handicap tournament for the Youth Tournament Prize Fund.

Tim Rutz asked if we should invite the winners of the Youth Tournament to the Hall of Fame/Awards Banquet like we do for the handicap tournament. He stated that we could comp their tickets and discount their parent's tickets from money from the Scholarship Fund. Mike Klein stated that we shouldn't treat the winners of this tournament different than the winners from the handicap tournament, and since we don't comp their tickets we shouldn't comp the Youth Tournament winner's tickets. The board came to the agreement to comp the banquet ticket for Youth winners only.

Tim Rutz thanked Cindy Ogden, Sarah Berger, Shelly Hennessy, and Chris Marshall for all of their help during the tournament. He stated that Chris ran the ball raffle (which Tim's daughter won legitimately), and that Cindy, Sarah, and Shelly jumped right in registering bowlers and writing down scores. Tim stated that the four of them allowed him to relax and enjoy the tournament. Thanks again Cindy, Sarah, Shelly, and Chris for a job well done.

Tim Rutz stated that the GCBA received two scholarship applications — one from a male applicant and one from a female applicant. As a result, the GCBA will award the male scholarship to Trevor Leitschuh from Highland High School and the female scholarship to Delaney Grimes from Highland High School.

The board discussed what we could do to get more bowlers to apply for the scholarship. Each high school bowling team coach and youth bowling leagues are given applications to give to their bowlers. Sarah Berger suggested sending an application to each high school that would have eligible applicants.

Tim Rutz stated that the USBC is very insistent that each local association director complete the SafeSport Program and Registered Volunteer Program. He stated that he received an email from the USBC showing who has and has not completed each program. The email also stated that if a director does not comply with these programs, he or she should be asked to leave the board of directors. The overall consensus of the board is that all of this is unnecessary for those board members that have nothing to do with the Youth Programs in the association, and that it is a legality for USBC to cover them if there is an issue. Chris Marshall stated that Registered Volunteers are restricted to communicate via social media to anyone under the age of 18.

Tim Rutz stated that the 2019 GCBA Hall of Fame/Awards Banquet is scheduled for Saturday, November 2, 2019 at Michael's Restaurant in Highland. He stated that Dave Wirz has agreed to chair the hall of fame. Tim stated that to the best of his knowledge, there are currently no applications on file. Applications will be accepted until July 1st.

Tim Rutz stated that Larry Wobbe, proprietor of V&H Recreation, is considering donating a hall of fame plaque in honor of his late mother for the female hall of fame members already in their respective hall of fame. Larry's idea is to put all of the female hall of fame members, past and present, on one plaque keeping the original GCBA Hall of Fame plaque for male bowlers. The board of directors was not receptive to this proposal. Sarah Berger stated that many of the female hall of fame members and families of the female hall of fame members would be livid if those female hall of fame members would be tied to the GCBA Hall of Fame and no longer associated with their original hall of fame. Tim explained that before they dissolved, the Clin Clair Women's Bowling Association recognized their hall of fame members with a plaque in each Clin Clair bowling center. Those plaques would remain. The board came to the conclusion that everything that happened in the past should remain in the past and that a small plate be put on the GCBA Hall of Fame Plaque stating the date of the merger. All new hall of fame members, male and female, would then continue on that plaque.

Tim Rutz stated that with our hall of fame growing and more tournament winners being invited to the Hall of Fame/Awards Banquet, we may need to find a bigger place to host the banquet. He stated that he thinks Michaels Restaurant can only hold 150 people. President Rinderer thought they could open up more partitions to hold more people. Scott Feist stated that he could probably talk the New Baden American Legion into waiving their fee if we want to hold it upstairs in the Legion Hall.

Tim Rutz asked the house representatives to look at the printout of the honor scores bowled so far this season and compare it to the scores bowled in their center to make sure all of the honor scores have been turned in and received.

Tim Rutz stated that the GCBA Senior Scratch Classic is scheduled for Sunday, November 3, 2019 at 11:00 AM at Bartelso Bowl. Entry forms will be available at the September meeting.

Tim Rutz stated that the GCBA Scratch Classic is scheduled for Sunday, December 15, 2019 at 11:00 AM at Salem Bowl. He stated that we are going to run a separate female tournament at the same time. Tim stated that a female bowler could bowl in both tournaments by paying separate entry fees. Sarah Berger questioned why a female bowler would have the opportunity to bowl in both tournaments when male bowlers can't. She stated that she thinks a female bowler should have to decide which tournament she wanted to bowl in before the tournament starts. The board agreed that a female bowler needs to decide before the tournament starts which tournament she wants to bowl in. Entry forms will be available at the September meeting.

Tim Rutz summarized the GCBA Membership Report for the 2018-19 season. The GCBA has twenty-four (24) USBC Mens Leagues compared to twenty-seven (27) last season. We have thirteen (13) Women's Leagues this season. Tim stated that he does not know how many Women's Leagues there was last season. We have fourteen (14) Mixed Leagues compared to thirteen (13) last season. 1768 USBC Membership Cards and fifty (50) local association membership cards have been purchased this season giving us a total of 1818 members compared to over 2100 last season.

Tim stated that five (5) bowling centers have eight (8) Youth Leagues with a total of 181 bowlers.

Tim Rutz stated that he would have the annual report completed shortly after August 1st. He stated that he would give the directors a copy of the annual report then having the directors give the annual report to their bowling center. Tim stated that anyone wanting their own copy needs to contact him. He stated that with help from Jeff Voss, the annual report would also be posted on the GCBA Web Site.

Tim Rutz stated that he is not planning to conduct any league officer workshops again this summer. He stated that he would distribute the league supplies to the bowling centers when he certified their lanes this summer. He stated that he has not heard if the state is planning a summer workshop. Tim stated that he would let the board know if the state sets a date for a summer workshop.

Tim Rutz stated that the USBC Convention took will take place April 29-May 2. He stated we will discuss the results of the convention at our September meeting.

Tim Rutz presented the 2019-20 GCBA Budget to the board. He also presented the 2018-19 budget and the actual/projected financial statement for 2018-19 so the board can see how close the budget was to the actual income and expenses.

Ron Maue made a motion to accept the 2019-20 GCBA Budget. Chris Marshall seconded the motion. The motion passed by a vote of sixteen (16) for and zero (0) against.

The following GCBA Directors are up for election to a three (3) year term starting August 1, 2019: 2nd Vice President, Pam Yates; Hanks Bowl House Representative/Youth Director, Shelly Hennessy; House Representatives Mike Klein (Mascoutah Lanes), Alan Profancik (Salem Bowl), Glen Summann (Vandalia Bowl), and Youth Director, Cindy Ogden. All six directors agreed to accept their reelection. There were no nominations from the floor.

Scott Feist made a motion to elect Pam Yates, Shelly Hennessy, Mike Klein, Alan Profancik, Glen Summann, and Cindy Ogden to a three (3) year term. Mike Gebke seconded the motion. The motion carried by a vote of sixteen (16) for and zero (0) against.

The GCBA Board of Directors scheduled the dates, times, and locations for the following 2019-20 GCBA Events: September 22, 2019 – GCBA meeting at 1:00 PM at Bartelso Bowl.

November 2, 2019 - GCBA Hall of Fame and Awards Banquet at Michael's Restaurant in Highland

November 3, 2019 - GCBA Senior Scratch Classic at Bartelso Bowl - 11:00 AM

November 17, 2019 – GCBA meeting at 1:00 PM at Hanks Bowl.

December 15, 2019 - GCBA Scratch Classic/Womens's Scratch Classic at Salem Bowl at 11:00 AM

January 26, 2020 - GCBA meeting at 1:00 PM at V&H Recreation in Breese.




