Coaching is only allowed between frames as long as it does not interfere with the flow of bowling. Bowlers must be ready to bowl when it is their turn to bowl.

This form must also be signed by each bowling participant.

GREATER CARLYLE USBC YOUTH TOURNAMENT RULES

1. This is an "OPEN" handicap tournament available to any male or female USBC Youth sanctioned bowler. Bowlers must be USBC Sanctioned. Unattached USBC membership cards can be purchased for \$7.00 (includes GCBA membership). Bowler must be a member of the Greater Carlyle USBC (GCBA). An unattached GCBA membership card can be purchased for \$3.00 if the bowler has already sanctioned paid his/her \$4.00 USBC dues.
2. Bowlers must use their highest 2018-19 USBC Youth Sanctioned League average with a minimum with a minimum of 21 games and must bowl in the Division designated for their age. High School Bowling Team averages can be used if bowler did not bowl in a sanctioned youth league or does not have 21 games in a sanctioned youth league. High school bowling team averages must be verified by their high school bowling team coach. All bowlers must be USBC Sanctioned. Travel League averages can be used. Bowlers entering after the March 31 deadline will be required to verify his/her average upon request or will have to bowl scratch.
3. The entry deadline is March 31, 2019. Entries must be postmarked by March 31, 2019. Entries received after the deadline will be allowed if space is available by paying a \$5.00 late fee.
4. Reentry is allowed if space is available. Bowlers can cash only once, with their highest score. There is no late fee for reentry.
5. Bowlers must be ready to bowl when it is their time to bowl. Coaching is allowed between frames as long as it does not interfere with the flow of bowling.
6. Bumpers will not be allowed during this tournament.
7. Check in starts at 9:00 AM each day.
8. This is a Singles Handicap Scholarship Tournament. Scholarships will be administered by the USBC "SMART" Program. All winners will need to provide their Social Security Number for the SMART Program.
9. Personal Appearance – Appropriate apparel required (apparel cannot promote profanity, tobacco, alcohol, or drugs).
10. Profanity or abusive language or behavior by any individual whether individual is bowling or not will not be tolerated.
11. Bowling etiquette will be used by all bowlers at all times.
12. Bowlers and spectators are responsible for any damage to the bowling center or it's equipment.
13. Electronic devices are prohibited during tournament play.
14. All rules not covered here are governed by appropriate USBC Youth Tournament Rules.
15. All decisions by the Greater Carlyle Youth Tournament Committee are final unless an appeal is made per USBC rules.
16. Preps (ages up to 11 as of 8/1/2018) will bowl three games. Handicap is based on 90% of 175.
17. Juniors (ages 12-14 as of 8/1/2018) will bowl four games. Handicap is based on 90% of 210.
18. Majors (ages 15-21 as of 8/1/2018) will bowl four games. Handicap is based on 90% of 230.
19. Male bowlers will bowl against male bowlers. Female bowlers will bowl against female bowlers.
20. Scholarship funds will be awarded based on the number of entries at a ratio of at least 1 in 6 bowlers.
