## 2025 GREATER CARLYLE USBC YOUTH TOURNAMENT RULES

- 1. This is an "OPEN" handicap tournament available to any male or female USBC Youth sanctioned bowler. Bowlers must be USBC Sanctioned. Unattached USBC membership cards can be purchased for \$7.00 (includes GCBA membership). Bowler must be a member of the Greater Carlyle USBC (GCBA). An unattached GCBA membership card can be purchased for \$3.00 if the bowler has already sanctioned paid his/her \$4.00 USBC dues.
- 2. Bowlers must use their current 2024-25 USBC Youth Sanctioned League average with a minimum of 10 games for the Bantam Division or 15 games for the Prep & Major Divisions. Travel League averages or School League averages can be used, but the bowler must also abide with Rule #1.
- 3. Bowlers must compete in the division designated for their age. Age divisions are determined by the age of the bowler as of August 1, 2024.
- 4. The entry deadline is February 15, 2025. Entries must be postmarked by February 15, 2025. Entries received after the deadline will be allowed if space is available by paying a \$5.00 late fee.
- 5. Reentry is allowed if space is available. Bowlers can cash only once, with their highest score. There is no late fee for reentry.
- 6. Bowlers must be ready to bowl when it is their time to bowl. Coaching is allowed between frames as long as it does not interfere with the flow of bowling.
- 7. Bumpers will not be allowed during this tournament.
- 8. Check in starts an hour before the start time.
- 9. This is a Singles Handicap Scholarship Tournament. Scholarships will be administered by the USBC "SMART" Program.
- 10. Personal Appearance Appropriate apparel required (apparel cannot promote profanity, tobacco, alcohol, or drugs).
- 11 Profanity or abusive language or behavior by any individual whether individual is bowling or not will not be tolerated.
- 12. Bowling etiquette will be used by all bowlers at all times.
- 13. Bowlers and spectators are responsible for any damage to the bowling center or its equipment.
- 14. Electronic devices are prohibited during tournament play.
- 15. All rules not covered here are governed by appropriate USBC Youth Tournament Rules.
- 16. All decisions by the Greater Carlyle Youth Tournament Committee are final unless an appeal is made per USBC rules.
- 17. Bantams (ages up to 7 as of 8/1/2024) will bowl two games. Handicap is based on 90% of 150.
- 18. Preps (ages 8-12 as of 8/1/2024) will bowl three games. Handicap is based on 90% of 180.
- 19. Majors (ages 13-17 as of 8/1/2024) will bowl four games. Handicap is based on 90% of 220.
- 20. Bantam bowlers will compete against each other boys and girls combined.
- 21. Prep and Major male bowlers will bowl against male bowlers. Prep and major female bowlers will bowl against female bowlers.
- 22. Scholarship funds will be awarded based on the number of entries at a ratio of at least 1 in 6 bowlers.
- 23. There will be four bowlers on each lane with a maximum of 24 bowlers per shift. The first bowlers to sign up will received their first choice.
- 24. Squad time are: Sunday, February 23 @10:00 AM; Saturday, March 1 @ NOON; Sunday, March 2 @ 10:00 AM; Saturday, March 8 @ NOON; Sunday, March 23 @ 10:00 AM; Saturday, March 29 @ 1:00 PM (this squad is limited to 18 bowlers).
- 25. GCBA Officials have the right to adjust the average of any bowler based on past bowling performances.
