GCBA HALL OF FAME CRITERIA

(Women)

PURPOSE: The purpose is to recognize, honor, pay tribute and perpetuate the names of Association members who, through the development and maintenance of superior bowling skills and abilities or provision of tireless, unselfish, dedicated and meritorious service to promote, improve and increase participation in the game of American Ten Pins, have made significant and beneficial contributions to the game of bowling in the GCBA.

HALL OF FAME COMMITTEE: The committee shall consist of eight (8) members, five (5) Board of Directors and (3) Hall of Fame members, shall be appointed by the President with input from Association Manager and Committee Chairperson of GCBA.

SELECTION OF NOMINEES: The HOF Committee will review all nominations submitted and select candidates judged by the committee to be most deserved of election. Candidates not selected by the committee for induction into the HOF will be retained in the GCBA file for consideration for the following two (2) years. The HOF Committee may elect up to five (5) nominees. 75% (6 of 8) of the total available votes are required for election to the Hall of Fame. There shall be only one vote per person.

CATEGORIES OF SELECTION: Members of this Association may be eligible for selection to this HOF because of outstanding bowling abilities and/or achievements, or for having provided meritorious service to the game of bowling over a prolonged period.

ELIGIBILITY: In order to be eligible for selection in either category, a candidate must meet all the following requirements:

- Nominees must attain the age of Fifty (50) by June 1 of the current year.
 Be or have been a member in good standing of the GCBA for at least ten
 (10) years. For Female applicants, must be at least ten (10) years
 combined with whatever Association that is absorbed into the GCBA.
- 2. Never been suspended from the United States Bowling Congress for any reason.

- 3. Have a history of regular participation in the Annual Association Tournament and other bowling events either sponsored by or supported by this Association (State, Regional or National Tournaments)
- 4. The candidate must have:
 - a, Established and maintained good repute in bowling and overall sportsmanship.
 - b. Demonstrated traits of character, personal and professional conduct while participating in sanctioned competition that is always exemplary in all respects.
 - c. Demonstrated abilities and willingness to help and assist other bowlers and projected an image that is respected and admired by bowling peers and served as an example for our youth bowlers.

In addition to the above general requirements, to be considered for selection to the HOF for bowling ability and/or bowling achievements. A candidate should also have:

- Demonstrate an ability to consistently maintain an average of 175 or above in league play.
- 2. Titles and/or top 3 finishes in GCBA tournaments, (this includes tournaments that were held in other associations absorbed into the GCBA), and/or State, and National Tournaments. Please list dates, scores, and final standing.
- 3. Bowling Achievements/Awards for High Game, High Series and/or any Association, League, State, or National Awards.

In addition to the general requirements to be considered for selection in the Meritorious Service Category, a candidate should have:

- Provide extended service as a league officer, house representative, bowling center proprietor/owner, and/or served on Local, State, Regional, or National Organizations as an Officer or Director.
- 2. Served voluntarily with USBC Youth Program, High School and Middle School Coach, Officer, or Director.
- 3. Regularly attended and represented this Association at local and out-of-town Bowling functions such as meetings, conventions, workshops, clinics, etc.
